The two main political parties in the USA

The two main American parties are the Republicans and the Democrats. Each party has a symbol - the Republicans have the symbol of an elephant while the democrats have the symbol of a donkey. The parties have a long history - the Democrats formed in 1828 while the Republicans formed in 1854 to oppose slavery [→ p. 102]. The main difference between the parties is that the Republicans are generally considered to be more conservative. Abraham Lincoln was a Republican.
